Xia Dynasty 2200 BC

Emperor Yu Dug canals Taught people to work together

No evidence stories are true.

Shang Dynasty 1500s BC

Social order important Royals, nobles, warrior leaders **Artisans Farmers** Slaves

First writing system Found on "Oracle bones."

Zhou Dynasty 1100s BC

Longest Dynasty

Social order

Kings, Lords and warriors, peasants

Brought order to China--Loyalty to King Later lords rebelled--Family vs. Family

Confucius--Taught respect. Failed.

Qin Dynasty 221 BC

Emperor Shi Huangdi

Cruel

Used Legalism (rules and punishments) Burned books, scholars

Unified China

Built Great Wall, roads, irrigation system. Standardized written language, currency.

Han Dynasty 207 BC

Emperor Liu Bang

Earned loyalty and trust.

Emperor Wudi

Used Confucius' ideas and teachings. Made family important again.

Art (painting)

Literature (poetry, Histories)

Paper, Sundial, seismograph, Acupunture

Silk trade (Silk Road)

1st century AD--Buddhism comes to China
