Hebrew Bible --source of History info HB also part of Christian Bible

God told Abraham to lead people Moved to Cannan--decendants=Hebrews

Later some moved to Egypt (cause=famine) Later Pharaoh made them slaves.

Moses- told by God to free Hebrews God sent Plagues. Hebrews freed. Exodus=Journey out of Egypt

Story told of Gods love.

Later God gave Moses 10 Commandments.

Hebrews returned to Cannan (40 yrs.) Fought to get land back. **Became Israelites**

Philistines invaded. Israelites united King Saul (not strong king)

- ---military skills, poetry (psalms)

King Solomon (great king) wise

- ---expanded kingdom
- ---built great temple

After Solomon died: Israel split--Israel and Judah (Jews)

- --2nd temple destroyed
